




Experience pure relaxation at our traditional Thermal baths. The Romans were well aware of the healing effects of warm springs when they established a health-promoting thermal culture in the Black Forest around 2,000 years ago, right where Badenweiler is situated today.

Relax in our Thermal baths, which offer the Dome bath, and the Marble bath as well as a recovering Outdoor pool that provides relaxation with its flow channel, massage jets and neck showers. From here, you have a beautiful view of Burg Baden and the Spa gardens.

Participation in our aqua aerobic courses is already included in the admission price.








Sauna world

Escape from everyday life, make time for yourself, breathe deeply and relax.

In our light-flooded Sauna world with a gallery and a rooftop terrace, you can enjoy sauna sessions in five indoor and outdoor saunas with varying temperatures, as well as a steam bath. Daily infusions are offered in the infusion sauna at certain times.

A special feature of the Sauna world is the textile-free Lindebad, a large thermal swimming pool with a water surface of 150 m².

You can cool off, swim, or relax in the bubble niches.



Roman-Irish bath

The textile-free Roman-Irish bath seamlessly blends the most advantageous aspects of Roman bathing culture and Irish bathing tradition into a harmonious experience.

Following a fixed sequence, you will visit steam and dry hot air baths one after the other, relax in warm thermal water and enjoy a soap brush massage at the end.

Afterwards, you rest wrapped in a sheet, in the relaxation room or in the fresh air on the Mediterranean-style rooftop terrace.

Please bring a large bath towel. Textile-free area. Minimum age 12 years.

- 2 Warm air chamber (dry)......50 °C 15 minutes
- 3 Hot air chamber (dry) 60 °C 10 minutes
- 4 Steam bath (Humidity 95 %) 50 °C 10 minutes
- 5 Shower
- 6 Thermal bath 36 °C 10 minutes
- 7 Dipping pool 12 °C
- 8 Soap brush massage* 10 minutes
- 9 Relaxation room or rooftop terrace

The thermal water in Badenweiler draws its healing powers from the geological layers of the Black Forest. When it has made its way to the surface at just over 400 meters above sea level, it creates an artesian spring.

This thermal water is especially helpfull for conditions such as rheumatism, joint or back pain, cardiovascular issues, and stress relief.
